The 2010 QATARMUN conference will be held in Doha, Qatar from Thursday January 28th to Sunday January 31st, 2010.

Model United Nations (MUN) is a student-run simulation of the United Nations, where students assume the roles of foreign diplomats to learn about international politics and diplomacy. Student participants ("delegates") are required to research both the country they will represent at the conference as well as the specific topics to be debated in their assigned committee.
