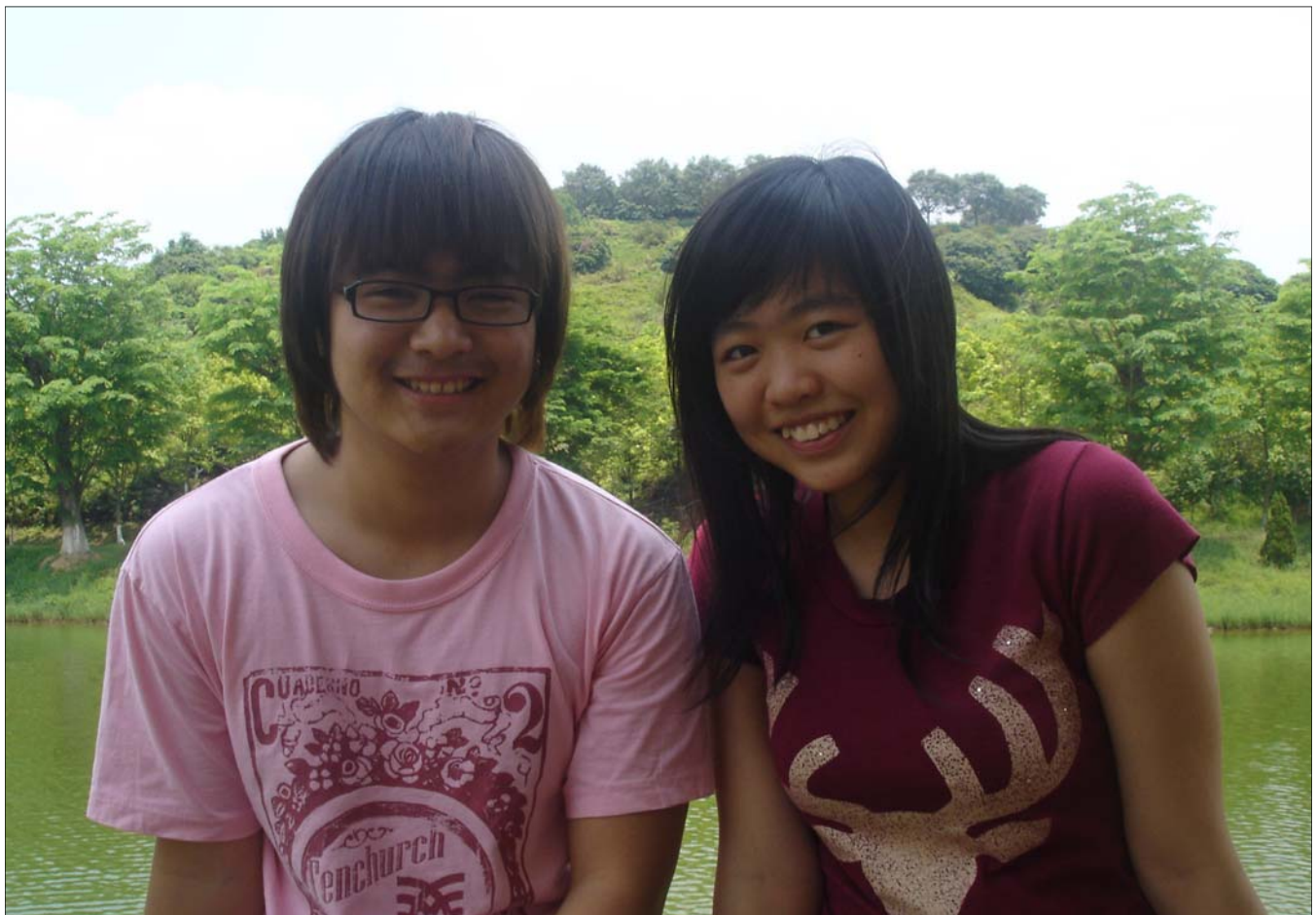




DRAGON HOUSE NEWSLETTER MAY 2009
