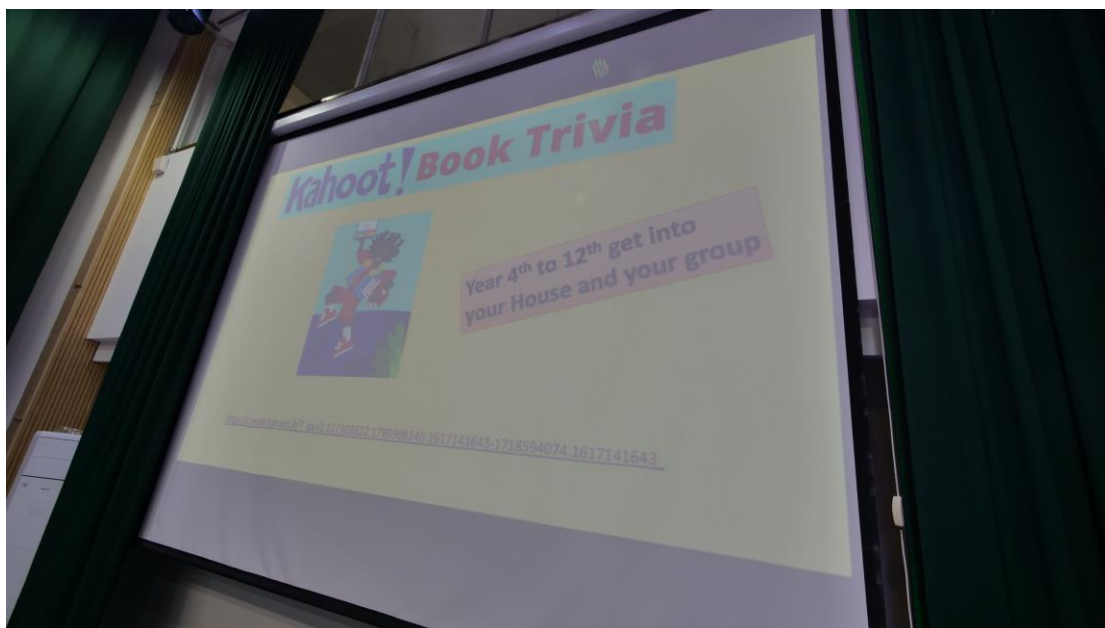






**Best Door Decoration Award (Secondary) went top Fire House**

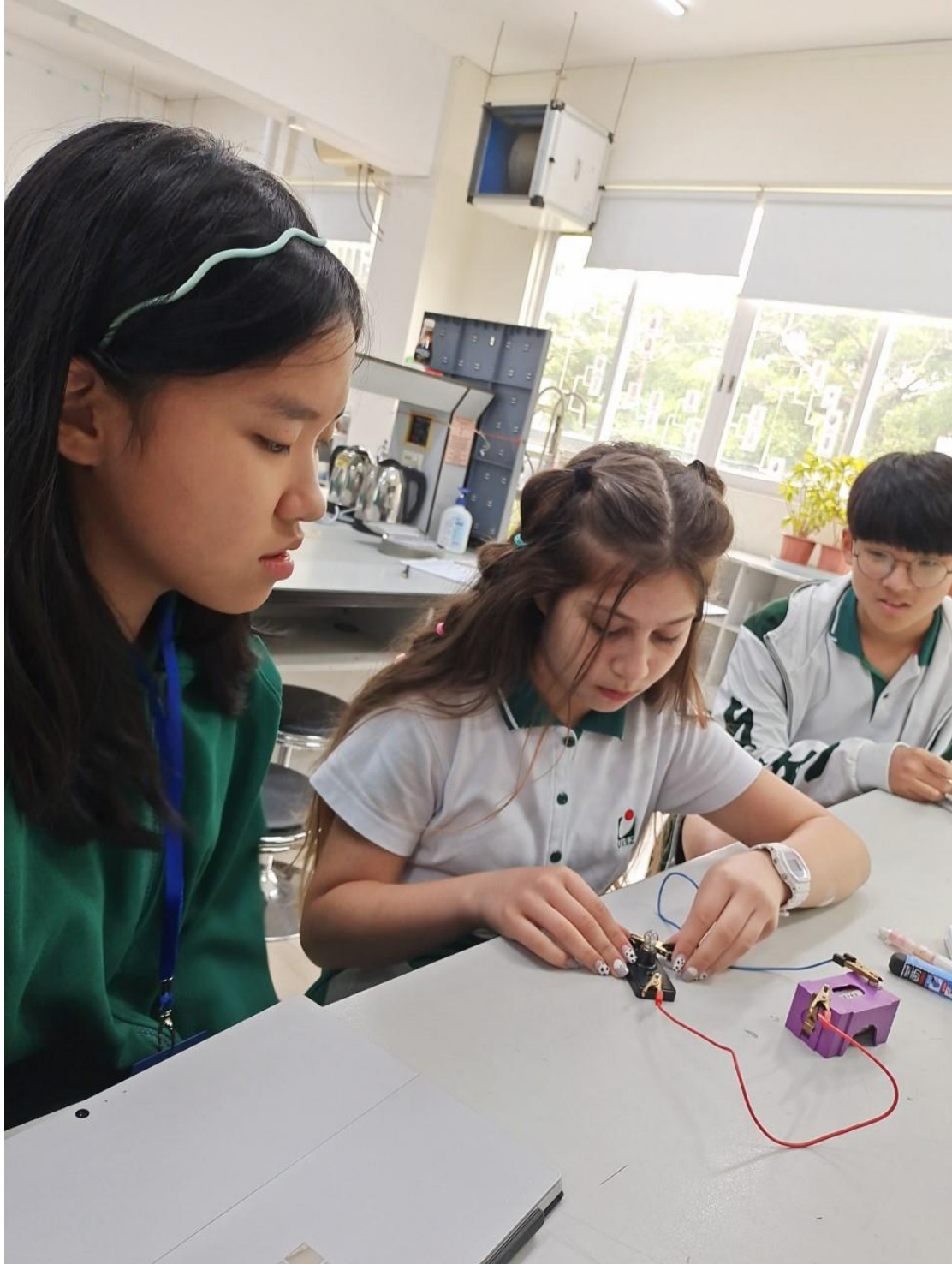


### Message from Ms Dina

## Message from Mr Anil

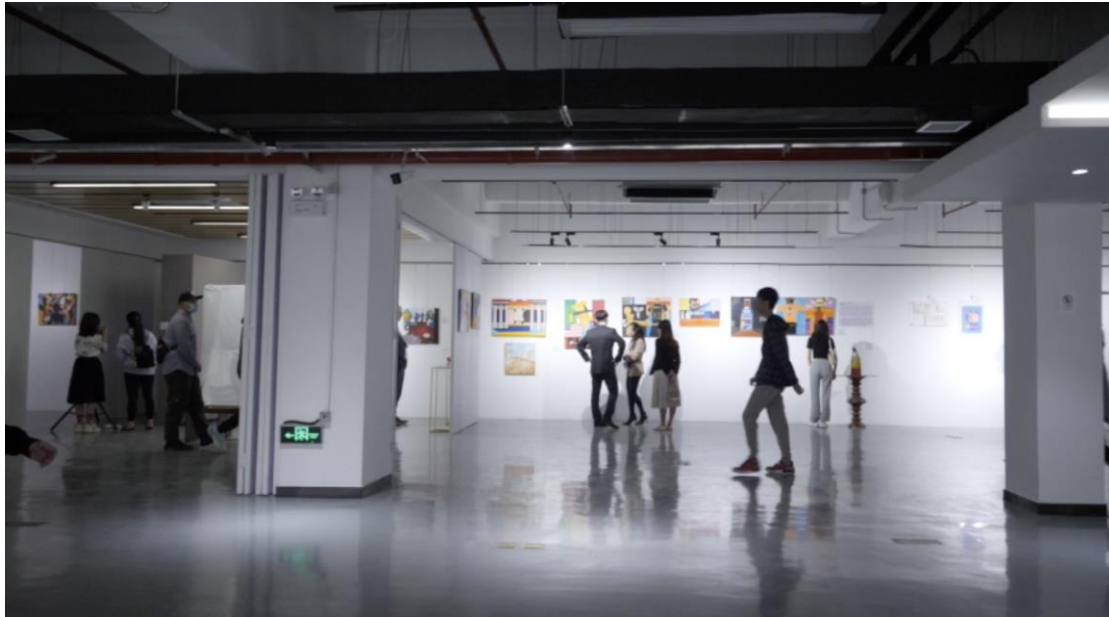
### IBDP Visual arts Exhibition\_ 'Observing Social Illusions'

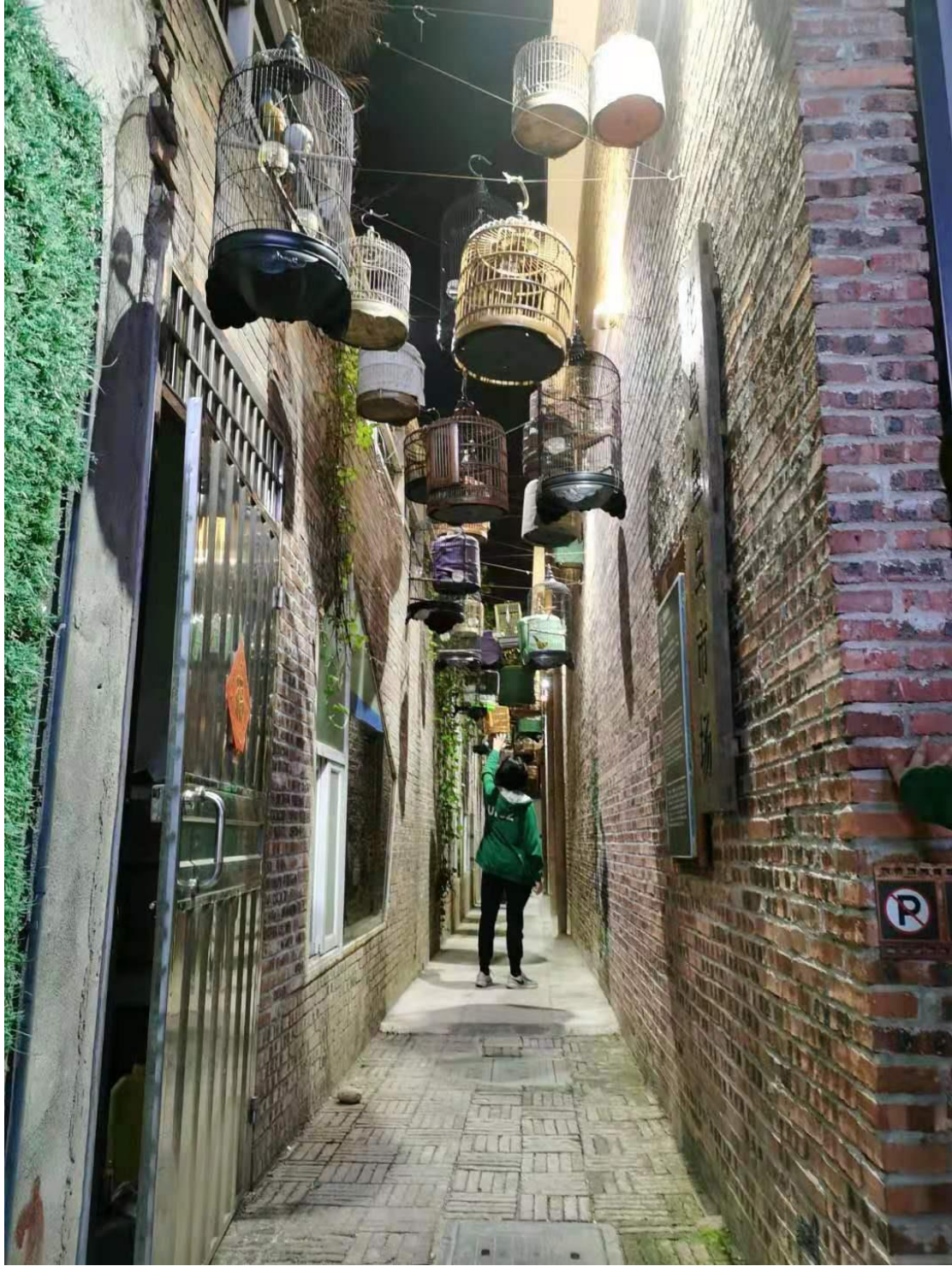
