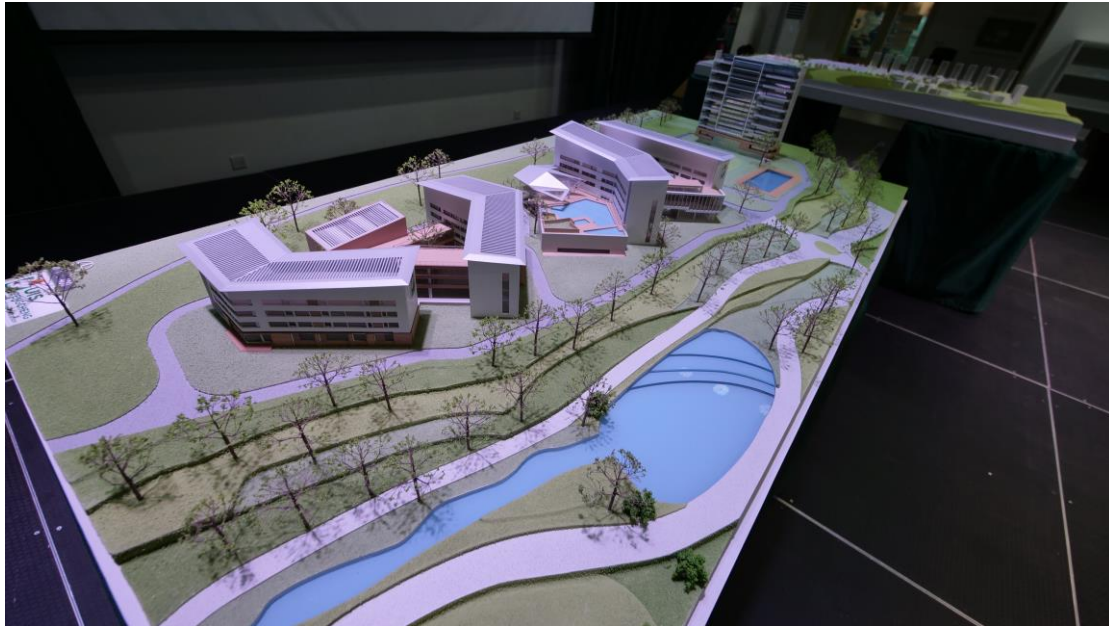


Later in the day there was a special presentation for parents and students on the new campus currently be constructed - given by the architect Mr Chow. The whole community is very excited to move into the new school once

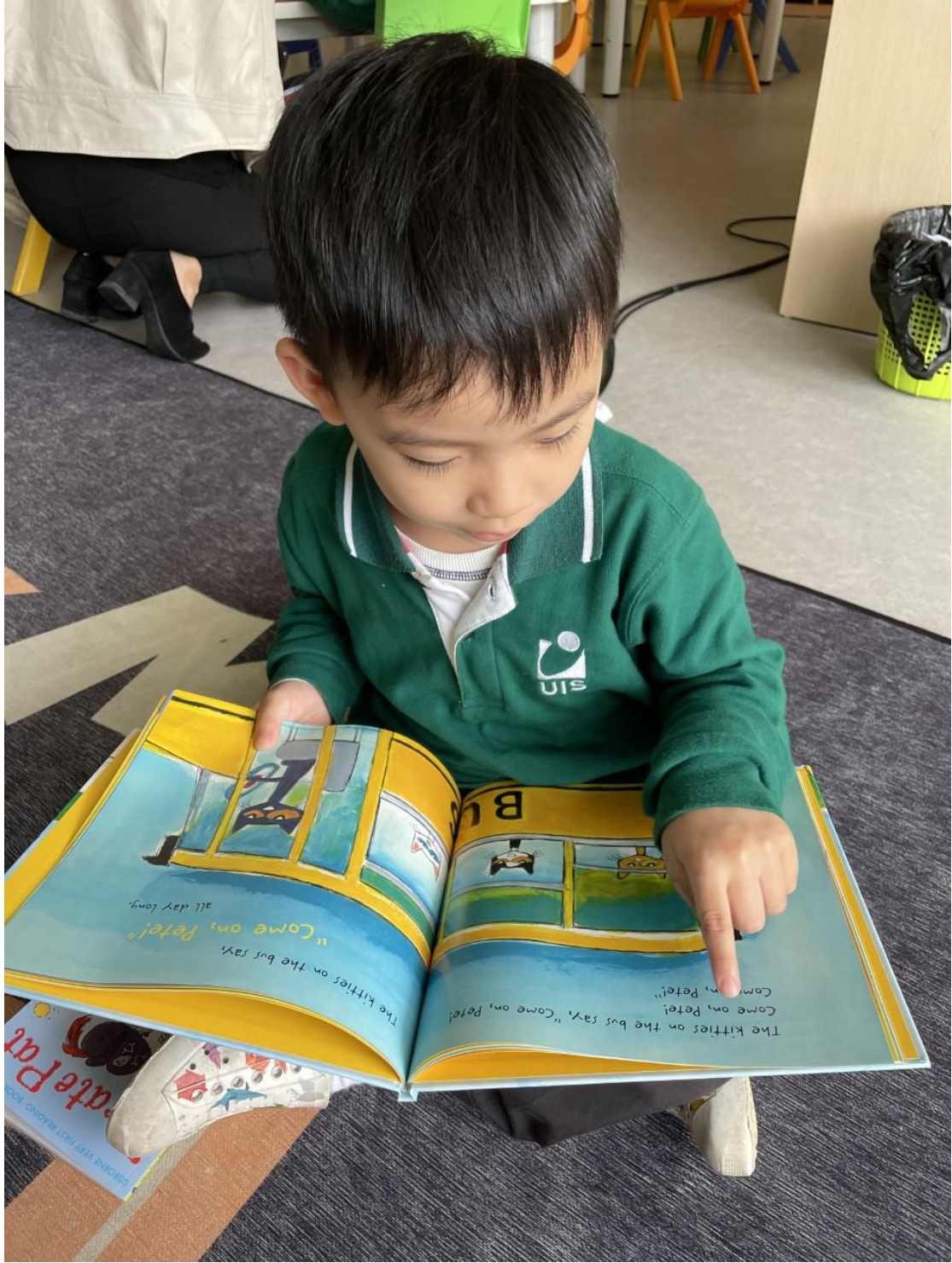
