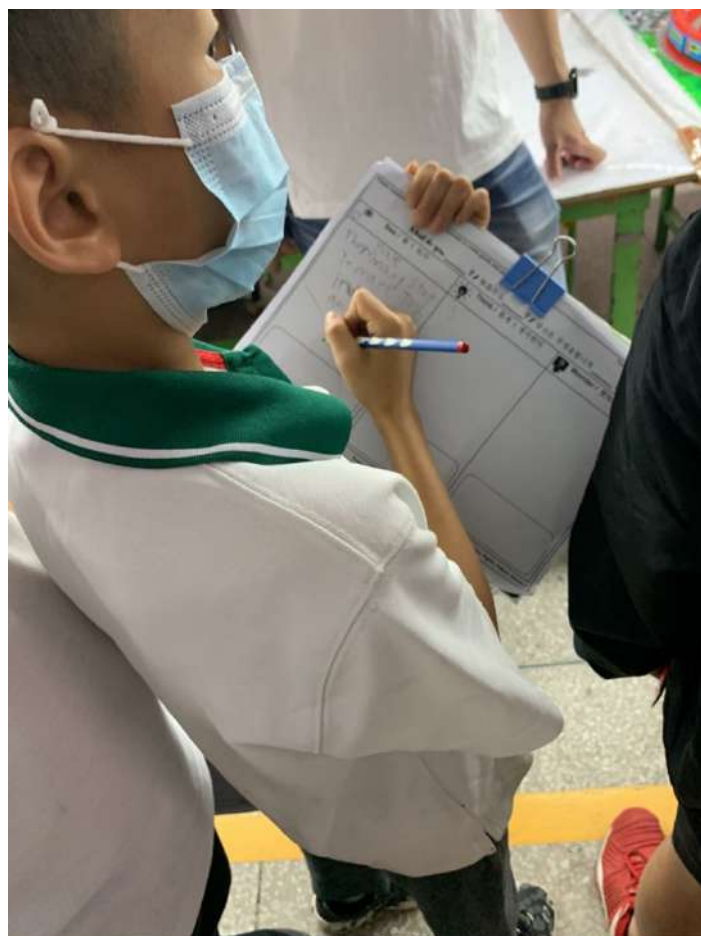
## PYP
