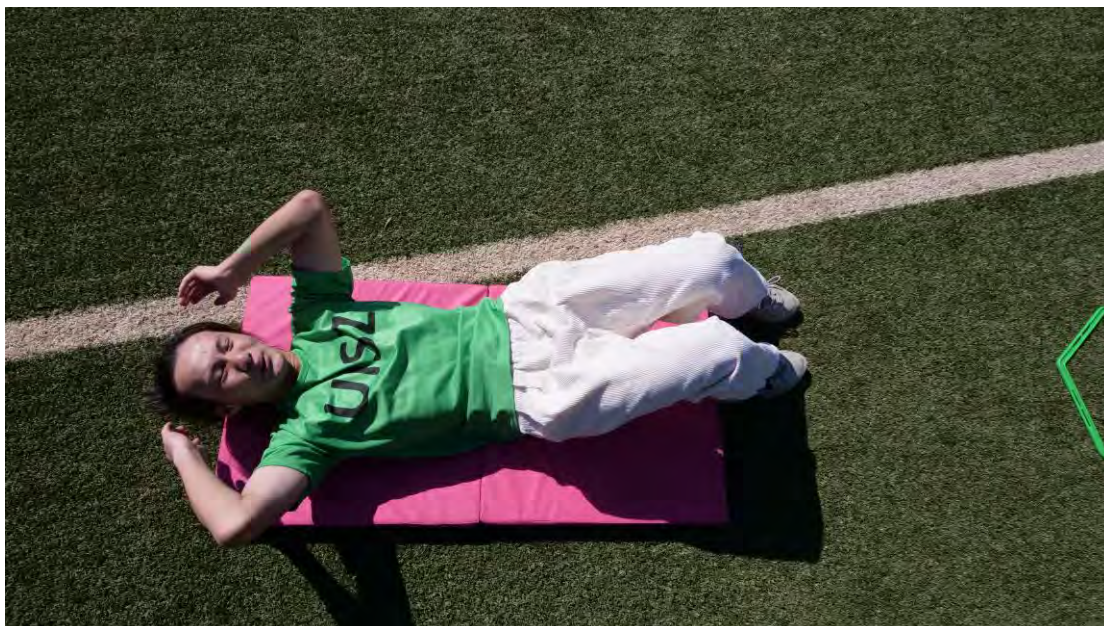




























### Message from Ms Holly
